How to Sew a Sweet Bunny Lovey



Materials:

- 2 contrasting fabrics, the softer the better, for the body and the ear
- Light smooth fabric for the face
- thread,
- scissors,
- iron,
- pins,
- sewing machine,

Step 1:

Cut a 21 cm square on your two main fabrics.

Cut 4 ears shapes (two of each fabric).

Cut a 6 cm square for your face piece.



Step 2:

With the right sides of your fabric together, use a 0.5cm seam allowance to stitch the curve. Leave the bottom open.

Turn the ears right-side-out with the help of an unsharpened pencil.



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Step 3:

On the face piece, fold in 0.5cm on two perpendicular edges. Use a hot iron to crease these folds. Flip the face piece over so the folds are underneath.



*** If you want to embroid the face and not draw/paint on it, do it now (see step 7)

Pin the face, folded corner down, to the corner of your **front** fabric square. Use a 0.5cm seam allowance to top stitch <u>only</u> the lower corner. If done correctly, the top will still be open.

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Step 4:

Take the two completed bunny ears and position them on the corner. Flip each ear over and in towards the face. They will overlap as shown below.



Step 5:

Align the **back** fabric square on top of the **front** square and ears, right sides together.



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Pin/clip everything together. Make sure to get pins/ clip through those ears!

Use 0.5cm seam allowance to sew around the edge, leaving a 5 cm hole for turning.

As you come around the ear corner, be *very careful* not to accidentally sew the long edges of the ears into the blanket seam.



Step 6:

Turn the bunny lovey right-side-out.

Top stitch around the entire square to close the hole and finish the edges.



Step 7:

Add eyes, cheeks and a nose with fabric paint and a detail brush. Let dry.

If you do not have fabric paint, you can use permanent marker in different colour.



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
